FINANCIAL FACTS

Phone or unpaid bookings will not be accepted; please complete and submit a commitment form.

50% of the total amount due is required as a deposit and is due and payable within 14 days after the receipt of the invoice.

Balance of the 50% must be paid three (3) months before the conference.

If the Supporter or Exhibitor misses the payment date, any time-dependent discounts will be forfeited (i.e., the Supporter or Exhibitor will be billed at the next highest level (early rate to standard, etc.)).

The Supporter or Exhibitor will not receive any supporter or exhibition entitlements, including, but not limited to, allocation of booth location until all monies have been paid.

All prices are in US Dollars.

If the Supporter or Exhibitor pays by electronic funds transfer or an international check, the Supporter or Exhibitor agrees to pay any bank charges and must include these in the amount the Supporter or Exhibitor transfers for each payment until balance is fully paid.

All Supporter or Exhibitor monies must be received before the conference.
